On September 11, 2001 four passenger airliners were hijacked by 19 al-Queda terrorists so they could be flown into buildings in suicide attacks. Two of those planes were crashed into the North and South towers of the World Trade Center complex in New York City. Within two hours both towers collapsed with debris and the resulting fires causing partial or complete collapse of all other buildings in the WTC complex, as well as major damage to ten other large surrounding structures. A third plane was crashed into the Pentagon leading to a partial collapse in its western side. The fourth plane was targeted at Washington, DC, but crashed into a field after its passengers tried to overcome the hijackers. In total, almost 3,000 people died in the attacks. **Let us never forget.**

It is appropriate to display the American Flag every day as long as it flies in accordance with the rules of the U.S. Flag Code. However, it is particularly important to fly the flag in front of our homes on the following days during December and January:

- December 7 Pearl Harbor Day (1941)
- December 15 National "Bill of Rights" Day
- December 16 Desert Storm began in 1991
- January 21 Congress established the U.S. Coast Guard in 1790
- January 27 Viet Nam cease-fire in 1973
- January 30 Franklin D. Roosevelt's birthday (14th Masonic President)

In Pasadena, CA on September 18, 1951 absolutely nothing of importance happened.
